

Call for Applications to second enrol in academic year 2019/2020

University of Belgrade – Faculty of Pharmacy

issues the Call for Applications to enroll students in the academic year 2019/20

for Specialist Academic Studies

Candidates applying for the Call shall decide on the following study programmes:

- Industrial Pharmacy
- Pharmaceutical Health Care

The planned admission in 2019/2020 is as following:

- Industrial Pharmacy: 2 candidates
- Pharmaceutical Health Care: 5 candidates

Candidates applying for the Call should meet the following requirement:

- completed general and master academic studies or integrated academic studies with minimum 300 ECTS

Candidates who apply for Specialist Academic Studies should fulfill the general requirements in accordance with the University of Belgrade as well as the requirements regulated by the Rulebook on Specialist Academic Studies at the Faculty of Pharmacy. Foreign students are enrolled according to the general requirements of the Call for Applications issued by the University of Belgrade.

Additional requirements on ranking:

- average mark achieved
- study duration
- average mark achieved in the subjects relevant for the study programme
- experience gained on relevant research projects and professional engagements

Candidates are granted the right to enrol the Specialist Academic Studies in **Industrial Pharmacy** if they completed the integrated academic studies or equivalent at the Faculty of Pharmacy or other profiles allowed to work in pharmaceutical industry on drug manufacturing in accordance with the Law on Drugs and Medical Devices and the Rulebook on Drug Manufacturing. Priority will be given to candidates who work in pharmaceutical industry. Candidates who did not complete the Faculty of Pharmacy prior to application have to pass the next exams: Pharmaceutical Technology and Biopharmacy, and the Basics of Industrial

Pharmacy - in accordance with the Programme for Undergraduate studies in force at the Faculty of Pharmacy.

Candidates are granted the right to enroll the Specialist Academic Studies in **Pharmaceutical Health Care** if they completed the integrated academic studies or equivalent at the Faculty of Pharmacy.

Prior to application a candidate must submit following documents:

1. certificate that confirms the knowledge of English language,
2. application form (available at the Faculty Archives),
3. original birth certificate, translated by certified court interpreter
4. certificate on residence permitted – Ministry of Interior in Belgrade, Division for Foreigners, address: 35 Savska, Belgrade
5. when applying, applicants – foreign nationals shall submit the certificate confirming that they have health insurance – Division for Foreign Insurance, Nemanjina 30, Belgrade.

Candidates who completed previous education abroad may respond to the Call for Applications if his/her acquired foreign high education documents are recognised in accordance with the Law and the relevant General Act of the University. If the recognition process has not been completed, such candidates will enclose the certificate confirming that the procedure is in progress to their application. Applicant being a foreign citizen when applying to the Call should submit the decision on the recognition of the foreign public document. Foreign citizens are required to pay the scholarship.

For candidates who have completed the previous level of the study abroad, it is necessary to submit the decision of the Rector on the recognition of foreign public higher education documents when enrolling. Applicants holding foreign higher education papers may apply for the enrollment in specialist academic studies with a decision on the recognition of a foreign higher education diploma for the continuation of studies at the University, and with the possession of a certificate of the initiated recognition procedure for the continuation of studies at the University; candidates with a certificate can only obtain conditional enrollment in the study program of specialist academic studies until the final decision is obtained. These candidates sign a statement that they accept the conditional entry until the decision is issued, and if there are obstacles for the issuance of a decision or the decision is negative, these candidates accept that they will not be allowed to complete the study program.

All candidates who completed the previous levels of education not later than September 30, 2019 have the right to enroll in doctoral academic studies in the school academic year 2019/2020.

The Faculty is obliged to check the submitted higher education documents and if it is found that the document has not been issued in accordance with the applicable regulations, the candidate has no right to enroll.

If it is subsequently established that the document on the completion of the previous degree of studies has deficiencies, the procedure for cancelling the registration will be conducted, in accordance with the Law.

Applicants who have a foreign higher education diploma must submit a certificate confirming that the recognition procedure at the University is in process.

Candidates granted the right to be enrolled but failing to do so within the defined time period shall lose such right, and the next ranking candidate from the list will be enrolled instead.

When applying under the Call for Applications, the candidates have to present original documents, and photocopies of the following documents which have to be enclosed to the application form (available at the Faculty Archives):

- **copy of the Diploma and Diploma Supplement on previously completed degree of education (in case he/she has no Diploma Supplement also the certificate on examinations passed)**
- **proof of payment of the fee in the amount of 3,000.00 for the purpose of application, paid to the Faculty account 840-1127666-05, code 189,**
- **A statement authorizing the Faculty and the University that the personal data provided by the candidate can be entered into an electronic database, and that the data can be used for the purpose of generating the necessary statistics, submitting the requested data to the Ministry of Education, Science and Technological Development without personal data, and will not be available to unauthorized persons,**

In addition, a brief CV is to be enclosed to these documents. Documents are to be delivered in person, to the Faculty Archives, in the 15th October 2019 and 16th October 2019 at 9 a.m. to 2 p.m., and 17th October 2019 at 9 a.m. to 12 a.m. The applicants may get information on the general requirements under the University of Belgrade (Call for Applications) on the University of Belgrade webpage.

DEADLINES AND PROCEDURE OF SUBMITTING APPEAL

The preliminary ranking list will be announced on October 22nd 2019 at 12 a.m. Applicant may submit an appeal to competent Commission of the Faculty on the regularity of the procedure established by the Competition as well as the ranking placement on the ranking list on October 22nd 2019 between 1p.m.-3p.m. and on October 23rd between 8 a.m. – 9 a.m.

Communication of the decision of the Commission based on the appeal will be on October 23rd 2019 at 9,15 a.m.

Submitting appeal to the Dean of the Faculty in the second degree procedure on the decision of the Commission will be on October 23rd 2019 between 9,15 a.m.-10,00a.m.

Communication of the decision of Dean will be on October 23rd 2019 at 10,15 a.m.

Final ranking list will be announced on the site of the Faculty of Pharmacy on October 23rd 2019 at 10,30 a.m.

Enrollment of received candidates will be done at the 25th October 2019. between 9 a.m. – 3 p.m.

All the changes will be published on the Faculty's website in a timely manner.
